Plural nouns

We add an extra syllable

/IZ/ for the plural -s or -es after

the sounds $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{3}$,

and $\frac{dy}{dt}$ (after the letters -s,

-ce, -x, -z, -sh, -ch, -ge).

We do not add an extra syllable after other sounds.
